

# Post office completes purchase of Oak Creek land

The U.S. Postal Service has completed its \$8.1 million purchase of nearly 64 acres in Oak Creek, where it plans to build a new mail processing center.

The agency bought the land, south of E. College Ave. and west of S. Pennsylvania Ave., from an investors group affiliated with Cobalt Partners, according to documents filed today with the Milwaukee County Register of Deeds.

The building, which will cover 820,000 square feet, will be developed by Cobalt. The center will have more than 2,250 employees and replace an obsolete building at 345 W. St. Paul Ave. in downtown Milwaukee and other facilities. Construction could begin this spring.
